To fulfill its mission, Malir University of Science & Technology will deploy all possible resources effectively and efficiently. The University is committed to provide higher education in the most demanding and traditional as well as newly emerging fields, optimally using the modern educational techniques to its maximum advantage.

Malir University of Science and Technology, Department of Health Sciences intend to prepare the young generation to be exceptional leaders in healthcare. Our core philosophy is that teaching and research should improve health and healthcare through the application of evidence-based practice.

BS in Health Sciences and Medical Technology Program at Malir University of Science & Technology is very innovative and it follows HEC's recommendation is spread over eight semesters. After completion of 138 credit hours in four years, students will be eligible to receive degree BS in Health Sciences and Medical Technology.

We groom our students to find effective prudent solutions through problem based learning. Before entering into practical life, our students are placed on internship training for eight weeks at a multinational or national organization, for hands on experience. We are also developing partnerships with universities in Canada and USA to place our students there for one or two semesters.

Admission Eligibility Criteria:

Intermediate with minimum 45% marks including first year and A – Level with minimum three passes

Admission Procedure:

- ❖ Admissions are given on merit basis on marks obtained in Board exams, aptitude test and interviews conducted by the university.
- ❖ Announcements of the commencement of admissions, its procedures and other details are provided through the university website.

Scholarship and Financial Assistance:

- ❖ We aim to provide higher education at highly subsidized tuition fee, specially to cater for talented students from low and middle income families.
- ❖ Adequate financial support is being made available for the award of scholarships and financial assistance to students on merit and need basis.

Our Academic Team

Dr. Mehtab S. Karim, the founding Vice-Chancellor of the university. Prior to joining Malir University of Science & Technology he has been a Professor of Public Policy and a Distinguished Senior Fellow at the Center for Social Science Research at George Mason University, USA. During 2000-08, he was a Professor and Head of Population & Reproductive Health Program at the Aga Khan University, where earlier he was an Associate Professor during 1983-90. In the 1990s, he worked at the World Bank and at the School of Public Health, Johns Hopkins University in USA and at London School of Economics in UK. In the academic year 2012-13, at the invitation of the Higher Education Commission (HEC) he spent two semesters as a visiting professor at Qaid-e-Azam University, Islamabad (Faculty of Social Sciences), University of Karachi (Faculty of Administrative & Management Sciences) and Dow University of Health Sciences, Karachi. Professor Karim has co-authored three books and has published more than 60 research papers and book chapters. He obtained B.A. Honours from University of Karachi, MS in Social Science from the University of Chicago, USA and PhD in Sociology / Demography from Cornell University, USA.

Professor Syed Sikander Mehdi, Director Academics and Acting Registrar at Malir University. He was a Professor and Chairman of Department of International Relations at the University of Karachi where he also served as a Registrar. Later he served as faculty at Shaheed Zulfiqar Ali Bhutto Institute of Science and Technology (SZABIST) and as Registrar of Karachi Institute of Technology and Entrepreneurship. Professor Mehdi is an accomplished scholar and has published over thirty papers and has presented papers in international conferences in Pakistan and abroad.

Professor Shershah Syed, is Head of the Department, Health Sciences and Medical Technology. He obtained MBBS Degree from University of Karachi, DORCPI from Royal College of Physicians, Ireland, Diploma in Family planning, Dublin, MRCOG Gynaecologists, London, Diploma in Emergency Obstructive Care, Uppsala University, Sweden, FRCOG from Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists, London. He is the former Head of the Department of OBGY at Sindh Government Qatar Hospital, Karachi, former Associate Professor of OBGY at Dow Medical College, Civil Hospital Karachi and former research Registrar, St. Hellier Hospital Carshalton and Addenbrooks Hospital Cambridge. He has been associated with served prestigious national and international NGOS focusing on human rights and health rights particular. His research papers have been published in Pakistan and abroad.
