Abu Zafar Institute of Medical Sciences was established in 2006 and started Midwifery Paramedics, Nursing training and Allied Health Sciences programs.

The Institute formally inaugurated in November, 2008 by former Chief Minister of Sindh Syed Qaim Ali Shah. The institute is having following units working under the administrative control of Abu Zafar Institute of Medical Sciences. These units are accredited with respective monitoring bodies.

The schools mentioned above are situated in the premises of Koohi Goth Hospital at Koohi Goth, Deh Landhi, Bin Qasim Town, Karachi whereas the colleges located at Malir Kalaboard Adjacent to the Atia General Hospital buildings. Koohi Goth Hospital is spread over 4 acres piece of land out of 16 acres. The hospital is known with lush green landscape, lawns, open theatre which gives pleasant look to the patients admitted and the staff and students working and residing in the hospital premises.

The hospital is committed providing all necessary facilities for its students and staff including three female hostels with free mess services. At present, the hospital provides three time meal to the midwifery and CNA students only without any charges.

Abu Zafar Institute of Medical Sciences (AZIMS) is the constituent institute of Malir University of Science & Technology and both run under the umbrella of Zafar and Atia Foundation Charitable Trust. AZIMS also has the collaboration with the Pakistan National Forum on Women's Health (PNFWH).
